



## ***April 25, 2009 Outdoor Conservation/Beautification Opportunity!***

***Join Clinton Co. CleanScapes, Penn College EarthSmart Students, City of Williamsport's Parks Dept. & Comcast Cares Day Employees as We Remove Man-made Debris from Banks of Lycoming Creek.***

**Where:** Meet at the Historic Bowman Field/Max M. Brown Memorial Park, City of Williamsport, Lycoming Co.  
*Directions: from Lock Haven, take Rt. 220. In Williamsport, take the Maynard St. exit #28. At the traffic light (Maynard St.) turn left (north) toward the City of Williamsport. Stay in right lane. Drive over railroad tracks, past Sheetz, past Penn College of Technology & W. Third St. At the "T" in the road (Thomas T. Taber Museum will be in front of you), turn left (west) onto Fourth St. ("Millionaires Row"). Drive 1.3 miles. Just **BEFORE** you drive over the Lycoming Creek bridge, turn right at Carl Stotz Place Road & into Historic Bowman Field/Home of the Crosscutters/Max M. Brown Memorial Park. Meet at the first pavilion on the left.*

**When:** 8:30 AM-1:00 PM – Complementary lunch & refreshments served at 12:30 PM.

### **Stewardship Volunteer Positions Available: Complementary Shuttle Service Available from Lock Haven-Register Early!**

**1. Restoration Crew:** Participants will remove man-made related debris from the vegetated riverbank of Lycoming Creek. Volunteers will bag such items as plastic bottles, discarded household items, metal & tires. The creekbank **may be muddy**, is rocky in some areas, slopes are moderate to steep & the woody debris can be sharp. Long pants & closed toes shoes are mandatory (no bare feet, shorts or sandals). An extra jacket, hat, shoes & socks are highly recommended.

**2. Photographers:** Documenting the event is very important & fun! If the volunteer photographer does not own a camera, volunteer/s will be provided film, a disk or disposable camera. The cost of film developing will be paid through CCC with the understanding that one copy of the photographs will become the property of CCC & will be used for educational purposes.

***Pre-registration is required by 12 noon on April 23<sup>rd</sup> & youth under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.***

Gloves, bags & safety vests will be provided to all participants.
