ELIGIBILITY

To be funded, all proposed activities must appear on the list of eligible activities as set forth in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Program regulations.

FUNDABILITY

Each proposed activity must also meet at least one of the national objectives of the CDBG Program as established by HUD:

- Benefiting low/moderate income persons
- Addressing slums or blight
- Meeting an urgent community development need.

Activities that do not meet one of these national objectives may not be undertaken with CDBG funds.

Additionally, the Clinton County Commissioners must certify that seventy (70%) percent of the 2007 grant will be used for activities that benefit low and moderate income persons.
