## Course Description

The American Heart Association's Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support Course is totally redesigned to incorporate new science evidence from the 2005 *AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC* and a new teaching methodology. Through the ACLS Course, healthcare providers will enhance their skills in the treatment of the adult victim of a cardiac arrest or other cardiopulmonary emergency. The American Heart Association's ACLS Course emphasizes the importance of high-quality CPR and the integration of effective CPR with advanced cardiovascular life support interventions. It also emphasizes effective team interaction and communication during resuscitation.

## Course Content

- BLS primary and ACLS secondary survey
- Airway Management
- Rhythm Recognition
- IV Access (Information Only)
- Use of Medications
- Transcutaneous Pacing
- Effective Resuscitation Team Dynamics
- 1-rescuer CPR and AED

## Provider Requirement

Providers must attend both days of instruction and successfully complete the written and practical examinations. A copy of your CPR card must accompany your registration.

## Renewal Requirements

Renewal students may be able to attend the second day of the provider course dependant on class size. If attending the renewal course, a copy of your CPR and valid ACLS card must be attached to your registration.

## Registration and Textbooks

Registration will be accepted until one week of the start date of the course attending. Upon receipt of your registration form and appropriate cards, a textbook will be mailed to the student.

## Course Preparation

Upon course confirmation and receipt of the textbook thoroughly reviewing the textbook is recommended. Students are required to complete the pre-course requirements and self-assessment.

## Course Location and Fees

The course will be held at the Lock Haven Hospital. Fees include textbook, refreshments, lunch, and other materials. Payment may be made by check or money order. Physicians please note the message on back page.

## Cancellation and Refund
