



PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
Clinton County 2018 CDBG program

A Public Hearing will be held on June 21, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' public meeting room, on the Second Floor of the Piper Building at 100 Mercer Drive, Lock Haven, PA to discuss the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, community development needs, the previous use of CDBG funds, the county's three-year community development plan, and the submission of a CDBG application for the 2018 program year.

The County is expected to receive an allocation of approximately \$225,000 in CDBG FY 2018 funds from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Proposed project activities must meet one or more of three objectives: benefit low- and moderate-income persons; prevention or elimination of slums or blight; and/or alleviation of immediate threats to the health and safety of the community. Clinton County Commissioners are required to and will commit not less than 70% of the total funds, after administration costs, to projects, which principally benefit low- and moderate income persons (LMI).

The following types of activities may be eligible for funding under the CDBG Program: water and sewer line replacement and improvements; housing rehabilitation; construction of affordable housing; construction/reconstruction of public/community facilities; recreational facilities; public services that are new or provide quantifiable increases in the delivery of services; street improvements; historic preservation; removal of architectural barriers; code enforcement; economic development; acquisition and relocation; clearance and demolition; and general administration, planning, audit if required, and preparation of the CDBG application.
