## **Notice of Special Election**

A Special Election to fill a vacancy for Representative in Congress in the 12th Congressional District will be held concurrently with the May 21, 2019 Municipal Primary. Consequently, all registered voters in Clinton County will be eligible to cast a ballot on May 21 regardless of their party affiliation on their voter registration record.

Voters who are registered with the Democratic or Republican parties will be eligible to vote on their respective party primary ballots to select party nominees to appear on the November ballot. They will also be eligible to vote in the special election to elect a Representative in Congress. Voters who are registered with all other political parties (Green, Independent, Libertarian, etc.) will be eligible to vote in the special election to elect a Representative in Congress.

Clinton County residents who wish to register to vote or update their name, address, or party affiliation on their existing registration record may do so by one of the following methods:

- Visit the Voter Registration Office on the third floor of the Piper Building, 2 Piper Way, Lock Haven, PA 17745 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:00am - 5:00pm; Wednesday from 8:00 am to 12:30 pm.

The last day on which persons may register to vote or update an existing registration record before the May 21 Municipal Primary is Monday, April 22, 2019.
