# **Bald Eagle Creek, Clinton County Community Clean Up Event**

*Join River Enthusiasts, Caring Community Members, Sunken Treasure Scuba Center, LHU students & Clinton County CleanScapes (CCC) in Removing Litter & Tires from Bald Eagle Creek in Bald Eagle Township.*

**All registered participants will be provided a pair of gloves, trash bags, & wood fired pizza from Curt's Smokin' Ribs of Mill Hall! Free LHU student bus shuttle service from the LHU lower PUB parking lot. Bus leaves at 9:30 AM & returns to LHU at 1:30 PM.**



### **Stewardship Volunteer Conservation/Beautification Cleanup Opportunities Available:**

- 1. Wading Crew.** Join CCC as they remove man-made related debris & tires from Bald Eagle Creek. Teams will wade in the creek & collect tires & bag man-made debris such as plastic beverage containers & metal. **Closed toed shoes are mandatory** (no bare feet, or sandals). An extra jacket, hat, sunscreen, shoes & socks are highly recommended. All teams will be guided by a CleanScapes Safety Captain. Goal: Remove 150+ tires & enjoy the scenic Bald Eagle Creek!
- 2. Photographer.** Documenting the event is very important & fun! Bring your camera & take photographs or short video clips of the volunteers in action. Email the photos/video to CleanScapes & we will submit some to local newspapers & the Clinton County CleanScapes Facebook page!
- 3. Land Support Team.** Assist the waders, truck drivers, or help load the roll-off dumpsters! As tires come to the creekbank you will retrieve their collected items and roll or carry them to a transport vehicle or load them into a large roll-off container. Sturdy shoes & a willingness to get muddy & wet are required!
- 4. Truck/trailer Shuttle Crew.** Drive your pickup truck and/or trailer to transport collected tires to the roll-off dumpster. After the tires and debris are removed from Bald Eagle Creek, participants will load your truck/trailer with the items. You will drive a short distance to the roll-off dumpster and another team of volunteers will unload the items. Please note, trucks/trailers may get muddy.

**Registration is requested by 12 noon, Sept. 4. Meeting location/map provided when you contact & register with CleanScapes.
